Mr. Storm has worked in Kazakhstan for over 27 years and he has been involved in a wide array of business activities, including oil and gas exploration and production, oil field services, domestic and international transportation services, and manufacturing. Mr. Storm is one of the co-Founders of Condor Petroleum, as well as a co-Founder and former Director of Osisko Mining, the developer of Canada's largest gold mine, Canadian Malartic.

Mr. Storm was also a co-Founder of Central Asia's first international transportation company which served many of the region's major resource projects, including the Kumtor Project in Kyrgyzstan, as well as the PetroKazakhstan, Tengizchevroil and Karachaganak projects in Kazakhstan. Mr. Storm's international transportation company was the founding member of KAZATO, the IRU's (Switzerland) customs bonding agency for road transportation in Kazakhstan and he was also the co-Founder of a joint venture which constructed two of the first manufacturing plants in Central Asia in 1994, based on western-technology.
